Rights to work in the UK.

There are several visa options available to candidates from commonwealth countries. Below is a outline of the visas available to the majority of candidates.

Tier 5 Visa

The Tier 5 youth mobility visa is available to candidates in most commonwealth countries between 18 - 30 prior to their 31st birthday. In order to secure the visa you need to show evidence of having £1890 in your account at the time you apply.

Ancestry Visa

The Ancestry visa is available to most people from common wealth countries who have a grandparent that was born in the UK. In order to secure this visa, you will need to show your grandparents birth certificate, your parents birth certificate, and your birth certificate. You may be required to produce marriage certificates as well depending on if the connection is on your paternal or maternal side.
