## Start your international teaching journey.

### Apply

Whether you met us at a career fair or found us online, you will start by submitting your contact details to us and possibly your CV. Why not do it right here on the website if you haven't already?

### Pre-screen

Once you have let us know you are interested in working abroad, we will get in touch with you to chat about the process and what options are available to you.

### Interview

Interviews can take place over the phone, in person in our local offices, or on Skype. Your interview will be booked during your pre-screen.

### Paperwork

We will send you a list of the documents required for interview and depending on the kind of interview, your references may be requested beforehand.

### 2nd Interview/Contract offered

If interested in a guaranteed supply contract, you can now start receiving contracts or if you're looking for a long term position, our local offices in the UK will start to find the ideal role for you.

### Preparation for arrival

Part one: we will help you prepare for the classroom by providing resources. Part two: we will ensure you have completed your visa and have the correct documents on hand prior to your departure.

### Arrival in the UK

We will ensure that you are booked for your initial meeting with the local branch you will be working with, for the day after you arrive. They will assist you with setting up everything you need to live here.
