Has face-to-face working been replaced with back-to-back or side-to-side working?			
Are workstations regularly cleaned with disinfectant?			
Are screens or barriers in place to separate workers where possible?			
Is production paused to increase cleaning protocols?			
Is there a one-way flow of workers around the plant?			
Are breaks staggered and can teams avoid congregating in canteens/locker rooms?			
Have you advised people to bring their own lunch in a sealed plastic lunch box?			
Are additional pop-up handwashing and/or hand sanitiser stations available?
